They possibly took over the Sagar farm at Simonstone, although Sagars are recorded as farming in the village until comparatively recent times. From Ron: I went to Garstang library today and had a browse in their reference section.

Here is an extract from "Dolphinholme Church and Village" by the former vicar A R Denne.

Hitherto, (ie before a private chapel was built by the mill owner) all spiritual ministrations, baptisms, funerals, and a quarterly Holy Communion took place at Shires Head, whilst marriages took place at Cockerham, the mother church of the old parish, several miles away.

Here is another extract from "The parish church of St John the Evangelist, Calder Vale"

The oldest buildings in the village incorporated a school room which was available for religious worship, but baptisms, marriages, and burials would involve a perambulation of three miles to Admarsh Church in Bleasdale, or, more likely, of over four miles through the fields to the Garstang Parish Church of Saint Helen's in Churchtown, or perhaps even Saint Thomas's in Garstang, then a Chapel-of-Ease (three miles distant by the shortest pedestrian route).

You might remember that William Swindlehurst gave his address as Shaw, Barnacre when he baptised his son James in 1828 at St Eadmer's. I believe the Shaw's is a farm on the entrance road to Calder Vale.

I do have some other goodies like maps, an account and picture of Spout House Farm. I have walked past it hundreds of times!

Prior to this date, the church accepted the marriage of girls aged 12 or more and boys aged 14 or more. In addition, a dispensation on licence could be obtained from a bishop which allowed marriage at a younger age. From 1763 a person below the age of 21 required the consent of parents to be married in England. **Age** - you will often find "of full **age**" meaning over 21. If it reads "minor" or "under **age**" this indicates between 12 and 20 years for a girl and 14 to 20 years for a boy. The **minimum age** for marrying wasn't raised to 16 years old until 1929.

1929 Abolition of Poor Law system in Britain. Minimum age for a marriage in Britain (which had been 14 for a boy and

12 for a girl) now 16 for both sexes, with parental consent (or a licence) needed for anyone under 21 The Age of Marriage Act of 1929 raised the minimum age of marriage to 16 years. (Before that it had been 12 for girls and 14 for boys although in practice such early marriages rarely happened.)

SUMMARY OF THE WILL OF ANNA SWINGLEHURST 1764

In the name of God Amen. I Anna Swinglehurst of Lady Lodge otherwise Clough Head within the parish of Bolton nigh Boliand in the County of York, widow of James Swinglehurst late of the same place, deceased do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following

1. To my executors all of my personal estate and securities for money and whatsoever I am entitled to on Trust to pay all my funeral expenses Depts, the expenses of proving this my Will.
2. To my son James thirty pounds which sum I do declare given to him in full satisfaction of every claim and demand which my son bath or may have upon me in respect of any grouts or profits of his Estate owed by me. But I do believe I have already amply satisfied every sum of money or benefit recieved and had by me in respect of that Estate by my having maintained and brought up my said son ever since his ffathers my late husbands decease.
3. To my daughter Anna fifty pounds.
4. To my daughter Ann fourty pounds.
5. To Stephen Jennings who married my daughter Isabel one shilling.
6. To Victor Wilson who married my daughter Ellen one shilling.
7. The residue to be divided into five equal parts one fifth to Isabel Jennings, one fifth to Anna, one fifth to Ann to be paid within one month.
8. One other fifth part to be put out at interest by my Executors and that interest to be paid annually unto my daughter Elizabeth who it is said is married to one Craven Cookson but of the validity of this marriage I am in doubt. I hereby direct that this interest shall be paid to the proper hands of my daughter Elizabeth for her own proper use and support and that the same shall not be in any wise liable for the riotous (?) intermedling (?) depts or engagements of the said Craven Cookson and that this interest shall not in any way be afsigned, aliened or otherwise disposed of during the joint lives of her and the said Craven Cookson the same being by me intended merely and only for her own personal support and maintenance. But in the case the same be in any wise aliened by her then that such interest shall be paid to my said daughters Isabel, Anna, Ann and Ellen. In case she shall die before this said Craven Cookson and have any child or children born of her body then I direct that the money shall be paid equally to them on attaining ages of 21 or day or days of marriage which shall first happen the interest in the meantime to be applied to their maintenance and education. But in the case any such children shall die before 21 or marriage then such share to surviving child or children equally. But in case my said daughter Elizabeth shall die before the said Craven Cookson and have no children born of her body living at her decease then this fifth to my daughters Isabel, Anna, Ann and Ellen share and share alike.
9. As to the remaining fifth I direct that the same be put out at Interest to be paid annually to my daughter Ellen the wife of the said Victor Wilson. (then follow similar provisions in respect of Victor Wilson as in the case of Craven Cookson above).
10. And I hereby appoint Emor Rishton of Brookthorn. Gentleman, my brother Hugh Atkinson. my nephew Nicholas Goldard and John Barcroft of Gisburne executors.

Ar: John Parker Swinglehurst was but a youth when his father John Swinglehurst died and he came under the influence of his grandfather Henry Parker who had been appointed his Trustee under the will of his father...John Parker Swinglehurst became involved in the manufacture of fine worsted material in the West Riding. The success of this business and the income from the Park Hill estate enabled him in 1780 to build a fine Georgian mansion abutting Park Hill. By then he had four children, the eldest John born in 1766, Elizabeth in 1767, Robert in 1769 and Henry in 1771.

Ar: THE SWINGLEHURSTS OF PARK HILL

In 1780 John Swinglehurst of Gill assumed the full title of Lower Park Hill and Park Hill and all the estates and lands lying on the east side of Pendle Water to the confluence of Colne Water in the south and including land as far north as Cross Gaits; It was a formidable estate.

John Bannister now pronounced bankrupt left Barrowford in 1710 with his family - a branch of that same family who were so closely associated with Alice Swinglehurst in 1580 and the unfortunate Isabel Tempest in 1537. It was Nicholas Bannister of Park Hill who, along with Roger Nowell an examining Magistrate, who sent the Lancashire Witches for trial in 1612. Their progeny today includes Sir Roger Bannister, the first man to run the mile within four minutes.

John and Elizabeth Swinglehurst took up permanent residence at Park Hill. She was the daughter of Henry Parker of Wheatley -yet another alliance with a Parker ! Three daughters were born before they had a son christened John Parker Swinglehurst in 1738.

There was an interesting episode in 1743. The Bannisters had for centuries worshipped at Colne Parish Church where they had their own private chapel. Believing that the ownership of the chapel went with the Park Hill manor a dispute took place between the two families which resulted in locks being put on the pews by one or other of the parties. The dispute was finally settled by a decree of the Consistory Court of Chester which gave "the northern moiety of the Choir and the four pews therein to John Swinglehurst and his successors with liberty to stand, sit, kneel and hear divine service and sermons with his and their families and tenants on Sundays, holidays and other opportune times and with the power to exclude all strangers who had not first obtained leave to enter". To Henry Bannister and his successors was reserved the right to continue to bury their dead replacing, immediately after interment, any seats taken up for the occasion. In consequence of this ruling, although they used the Colne Church for worship, the Swinglehursts chose to bury their dead at Newchurch in Pendle.

John Parker Swinglehurst was but a youth when his father John Swinglehurst died and he came under the influence of his grandfather Henry Parker who had been appointed his Trustee under the will of his father. The Industrial Revolution was in its infancy at this time although the Barrowford district had long been connected with the woollen industry, many people employing themselves in handloom weaving in their own homes. Henry Parker and his daughter, the widow Elizabeth Swinglehurst, reasoned that with the strides now being made in industry in other parts of the country the future lay in manufactured goods and not so much in farming. Consequently, the young man at the age of 18 was in 1756 apprenticed to Richard and William Hodgson of Bradford, Yorkshire, "Stuff Makers". The term of apprenticeship was four years during which period, in return for being instructed in the business, it was laid down that the youth was to serve his masters - "well and faithfully, guard their secrets, keep their lawful demands everywhere to the best of his power and to do no injury to his masters". Further, "he shall not do nor willingly suffer injury to be done by others, but give notice of the same to his masters, not embezzle, damage, waste or spoil any goods. Cards, dice or other unlawful games he shall not play, nor attend alehouses or sports, nor commit matrimony. Keep good and regular hours at morning, noon and night and behave at all times as good and faithful apprentice".

The Amount to be paid in the instruction of the apprentice and the provision of food and drink and lodging in Bradford was one-hundred pounds. In addition the boy was to be provided with a horse by his mother to enable him to make the journey over the Pennines at holidays and to enable him to visit the firm's customers.

It may have been the intention to convert the old mill in the meadow to the south of the house to a worsted or cotton mill but at the conclusion of the apprenticeship John Parker Swinglehurst became involved in the manufacture of fine worsted material in the West Riding. The success of this business and the income from the Park Hill estate enabled him in 1780 to build a fine Georgian mansion abutting Park Hill. By then he had four children, the eldest John born in 1766, Elizabeth in 1767, Robert in 1769 and Henry in 1771.

The old Barrowford Mill had been retained by the Bannisters and let to other operators, but the Swinglehursts made a charge for the supply of water from the top of the waterfall to the mill dam and thence to the water wheel. In 1783 the Bannisters were obliged to sell the mill in order to raise sufficient money to pay a debt of two-hundred and fifty-three pounds to John Parker Swinglehurst. The new owners then negotiated for the purchase of the mill dam and this transaction was completed in 1800.

John Parker Swinglehurst had only lived in his new house for three years when he died in 1783 at the relatively early age of 45. His son John succeeded him when he was only 17. He and Henry had received their early education in the village from a Mr. Hargreaves who conducted classes for as little as three pence a week. Pupils came from as far away as Foulridge and Blacko and their names and progress were dutifully logged in the schoolmasters diary and account book. Henry Swinglehurst, we learn, attended for six years at a guinea a year but John's education appears to have cost 12d per week - a higher fee than was charged to other pupils. Perhaps he was a more difficult pupil or perhaps his search for knowledge was more demanding. [More probably he was subsidizing all the others or it could have included lodging.] John eventually became involved in business in Halifax like his father, but evidently spent most of his time at Park Hill making occasional journeys by horse back on the difficult moorland road via Hebden Bridge to Halifax. (See "Park Hill after the Swinglehursts" regarding the family's involvement in Halifax with the Parkers.)

The estate had grown in size by the addition of several farms following the death of Henry Parker, his grandfather. Farm management therefore demanded more of his time particularly when in 1792 the Leeds and Liverpool Canal Company brought their excavations to the Barrowford boundary with Colne and acquired quite a slice of the Park Hill land. The construction of the locks and the 1,630 yard long Foulridge tunnel caused some excitement in the village but the digging of a large reservoir to service the canal on land adjoining the estate changed the whole character of Park Hill. This reservoir now impeded the old road from Clitheroe to Colne and a new road had to be made from Colne to Barrowford and this passed directly in front of the house. By 1796 the whole project was completed and the canal opened.

In 1792 John had been appointed Overseer of the township of Barrowford and some notes from the Overseer's books make interesting reading. A skilled man's wage at this time was 1/6d to 2 shillings per day. The cost of building ten houses at Pendleside including everything - £542.1s.2de. In 1794 "candels" for the meetings cost 1/2d and the sums of £44.5s.6d, and £50.18s.6d.s was paid as the town's share in raising seamen for the war with France following the revolution in that country. A note in 1804 says simply - Defence of the Realm - six men wanted, none went "" £2.0s.3d- and in 1806 the town had to pay a fine of £22.2s.9d. for failing to raise men under the Additional Forces Act. It would appear that the disquieting rumours of invasion by Napoleon in 1804 had little effect in the district although a special meeting chaired by John Swinglehurst was called to discuss what should be done.

Meanwhile work on the Estate had been continuing apace and John Swinglehurst found it necessary to enlist the help of his old schoolmaster who once again turned to his account book and recorded that in 1795 he went to one of the Swinglehurst farms near Trawden to measure the hay. For this he charged 3/6d. He charged a further 3/- for copying a Church Book for John and 8/6d for five days work making maps of the estate.

Great changes were taking place in England's main road system which became totally inadequate for the new industrial society and a new road - a turnpike was planned for Burnley via Marsden (Nelson), Barrowford and Gisburn to Hellifield. John Swinglehurst became a member of the Turnpike Trust with the powers to raise tolls on the road. A Toll Bar was constructed on the road by Park Hill and an old map shows it was necessary to acquire land from the Swinglehursts and others to make a more direct route to the village or as it frequently referred to "town". At this time (1801) it had a population of 1224, and Colne had 2476 and Burnley 3305.

The new Turnpike was open by 1810 and three new bridges were built replacing the old fords. The old cart track through Park Hill farm fell into disuse.

By 1819 the new Cotton Industry was in turmoil and wages were having to be reduced. There were demonstrations by workpeople and many were on the breadline. Handloom weavers from Colne and Barrowford congregated outside the Nelson Inn in protest but happily the affair passed off peacefully helped by the landlord's liquor and when this was consumed many set off for Holgate's Marsden Brewery for further supplies. But such was the plight of many of the villagers that a Workhouse was constructed in the Square and John Swinglehurst was appointed Chairman for the Care of the Poor.

This was the year that Stage Coaches commenced running between Leeds and Liverpool calling at Colne. By 1826 it seemed a full time job caring for the poor. Mobs were afoot, particularly in Colne where new looms were being destroyed in transit.

In 1830 John Swinglehurst died - the last of the Swinglehursts of Park Hill. His memory is perpetuated in Colne Parish Church with a tablet in the Bannister Chapel - his body lies at Newchurch in Pendle with others of the family - a result of the edict of 1743. Over his memorial is a Coat of Arms he had adopted - the crest appropriately a boars head from the origins of the family in Bowland and five sheaves of corn on the shield denoting no doubt the large amount of land he owned - farms in Trawden Forest and in Gisburn Forest - Lumb Laithe Farm, Boulsworth Dyke, Lodge Moss, and two cottages - farms in Admergill between Blacko and Gisburn, farms in Barrowford and Blacko - Trough Laithe, Clough Farm, Fulshaw Farm, Higher Park Hill, Cross Gaits Farm and the Inn there, Malkin Tower Farm, Lower Park Hill and many cottages and other dwellings.

The old Inn at Cross Gaits has the carved stone legend over the door - "Good ale tomorrow for Nothing" - a typical Swinglehurst joke '.

Nancy's father records the birth of son (Robert) to Nancy in 1811. Nancy would have been 16/17 years old at the time. There is no baptismal entry for this child in Slaidburn. Nancy married John Sutton in 1816. Nancy's nephew John who became a member of the LDS Church records Robert as the son of his grandparents John Sw. and Ann Clarkson. As Nancy was their youngest child, born 1794, it seems unlikely that her mother would still be of child-bearing age in 1811. No baptism is recorded for Nancy but her birth is recorded in John Swindlehurst's hymn book as well as in the Mormon Family Record compiled by his grandson John Swindlehurst.

The birth of Robert in 1811 is recorded in the hymn book of John Swindlehurst and Nancy Swindlehurst is named as the mother. The baptism of Robert appears in the PR of Whitewell and there is no father listed, often a sign of a birth out of wedlock. Nancy (Robert's listed mother) was John's youngest child born in 1794. Nancy did not marry until 1816. In the LDS Family Record Robert appears as the son of John and Ann Swindlehurst who were, most probably, his grandparents. It seems unlikely that Ann, by 1811 probably in her mid-fifties, would be the mother of this child and more likely the grandmother who raised him as her own for her daughter, Nancy. Robert was the only child of these two generations of SWINDLEHURSTs and SUTTONs who was baptised at Whitewell and not Slaidburn.

John married Ann Clarkson a spinster at Slaidburn on 26th February 1781. John was a blacksmith and he signed his name Swinglehurst. Ann was from the parish of Slaidburn; the witnesses were Ellin Clarkson and Charles Clarkson. After the marriage the newly weds moved to Root in Dunsop Bridge and remained there until their deaths. They had children who were christened at Slaidburn:

(1) 13th October 1781, William son of John Swinglehurst of Root. *Born 29th September 1780. Died at Preston St Pauls*

(2) 20th April 1783, John son of John Swinglehurst of Root. *Born 26th March 1783 died Preston St Pauls.*

John had an interesting life. He married twice. His first wife Margaret Hopwood, born 1812 died 21st September 1851 in Clough End Haslingdon.

They had a number of children few of whom survived infancy. His second wife was Matilda Rothwell. Born 15th July 1830 died 19th October 1875 in Beaver, Utah, USA.

Their first child Isabel Hannah was born 30th January 1853 in Haslingdon and died Isabel Hannah Orwin on 26th September 1913 in Provo, Utah, USA.

John and Matilda converted to Mormons and intended going to the USA in 1863. They were booked to sail on the ship Antarctic from Liverpool on 23rd. May 1863 arriving in New York 10th July 1863. They intended taking their children Isabella born 1853. Sophia born 1856. Charlotte born 1857. Amelia born 1860 and William born 1863. They were on the ships manifest and are recorded as sailing to America. They did not in fact do so and some other persons, unknown, went in their place. William born 1863 was buried in Accrington whilst the Antarctic was at sea. They did sail to the USA in 1868. Sailing from Liverpool 14th June 1868 on the Colorado arriving in New York 28th July 1868. The

family was the same except for the loss of William and the addition of Edwin born 1865 and Thomas Wilford born 1868. They remained in America where they settled in Beaver Utah.

The following is from a biography written by James Swindlehurst's grand daughter and sent to me by Lee Starnes a descendant in America.

"it says the family left Liverpool on the "Colorado" July 15, 1868. They noted this was Grandma's birthday which is why they remembered the date. The ship log says it left July 14th 1868. Now as to the other ship record, from what I piece together from the family history, The family had planned to leave on the "Antarica" but the baby William who was the first son of John by wife Matilda became sick. They must have decided to stay but sent John's son John Jr (from his first marriage to Margaret Hopwood) with his 2nd wife Matilda's mother Sophia Barnes and her two daughters. Baby William died and was buried at Baxenden, Accrington, Lanc. The John Swindlehurst's stayed in Stakes Livery, Blackburn, Lanc until they sailed because they had two more children born there. Edwin 28 May 1864 and Thomas Wilford 20 Mar 1867. Their last son was born in 1871 in Beaver, Utah. I don't know why the ship did not correct the passenger list but the family did not sail. William died in England while the ship Antartica was on the sea."
"John (1812) and his wife settled Beaver, Utah. There was a textile mill there and his wife Matilde and daughter Isabel (who was born in Haslingdon) wove in the mill. There is a plaque commemorating the weavers which lists them somewhere in Beaver, Utah"

In 1779 John Swindlehurst bought himself a notebook in which he recorded the details of his family. He also wrote 108 pages of psalm settings written for a quartet. There were also a number of patriotic songs of the period written in the book. There was a TV programme recently in which an early 19th Century Slaidburn wedding was re created. Musical instruments of the day were used and John's music was played. (*Family information from the notebook is written in italics.*) The notebook is in the possession of an American lady called Marie English. She is a direct descendent of John through his son James and his grandson John who was born in Dunsop Bridge on 25th October 1812. Died in America at Beaver Utah in April 1889. There is mention in the notebook of 2 further children of John Swindlehurst of Root.

Robert appears to be recorded as a son of John and Ann being born on 10th February 1811. He died in Halifax.

Robert is recorded as christened at Whitewell 10th March 1811 as the son of Mary or Nancy Swinglehurst. Not John and Ann. John and Ann did however have a son Robert. Christened at Over Wyresdale 8th March 1795.

It would appear likely that the Robert born 1811 and Christened at Whitewell was a child of Nancy before she married John Sutton and may well have been brought up by John and Ann as their own.

There is an entry on the cover of the notebook which shows Nancy Clarkson daughter of Margaret Clarkson Born April 15 in 1779.

There is no trace of Nancy at Slaidburn but there is a Nancy Clarkson, daughter of Margaret baptised at Over Wyresdale on 21st May 1780.

There is also a marriage recorded at Slaidburn on 14th February 1814 of Robert Kenyon to Nancy Clarkson. The witnesses are John Swindlehurst and John Swindlehurst.

Dyanna explains in a prior e-m:

I also agree about the James/Isabel tree but I do have additional info. that is not/was not available to the people who added info via the IGI. Some 10 years ago now I had a contact with a Marie English who lives in Michigan. Her connection to SW is via the surname SUTTON. She had found a book in her loft.

It was originally a blank book.

Front cover and page 1

On the front cover is a list of various family dates of birth which continues over the next page.

Page 2

"John Swinglehurst his Psalm Book Bought in the Year 1779 October 8th"

(Then the handwriting changes and there is a very ornate inscription)

1836

1779

"John Swindlehurst Singing Book Bought at Lancaster October 8th 1790

Robt. Bleazard"

*Notice the discrepancy in the dates there - 1779 and 1790.

The rest of the book (108 pages long) has been hand ruled as music manuscript and written in are various psalms and folksongs of the day.

This book was that of John Swindlehurst born 1756 in Slaidburn and who married Ann Clarkson. The book was passed on to their dau Nancy who, in 1816 married John Sutton. A number of John and Nancy Sutton's children emigrated with their families to Michigan and the book went with them. Meanwhile Nancy's brother James married Isabel Lancaster. Their eldest son John (b 1812) married Margaret Hopwood. They had 7 children. Margaret and 6 of the 7 children died between 1840 and 1851. Margaret died in Sept 1851 and John married Matilda Hopwood in Jan 1852!! They had 8 children and it was this family that emigrated to Utah as John became an LDS member along with the rest of his family. It was John who wrote a record of his family for the LDS.

I have a transcript of the hymnbook contents that I will scan and send you. I did have it on computer but have somehow lost the file and only have a paper copy.

Dy's original transcription consists of two pages stapled together. My following copy will attempt to reproduce both its layout (though subject to WordPad spacing inconsistencies) and exact spelling etc.

Dy: I forgot to tell you that one of the pieces of music in the hymnbook of John Swindlehurst was a wedding anthem by William Knapp. I reset the old style score into modern-day music manuscript, gave it to a Wyresdale choir called 'The Gladly Solemn Sound' and it was featured in what has become known as 'The Slaidburn Wedding'. A young couple who were marrying at Slaidburn wanted a wedding in the style of the 18th century. Everything about the wedding was in that style. The whole event, preparations and all, were made into an hour long TV programme. I have it on a video tape and am going to try and get it transferred to DVD. I'll let you have a copy when I've had it transferred.

Dy: Interestingly, part of Mary Hargreaves [branch] lived and worked in Dunsop Bridge. They were both blacksmiths and whitesmiths. They had all their children baptised in Slaidburn except the one illegitimate child who was baptised in Dunsop Bridge! Perhaps they had turned coat from Rc to C of E? This is the family that John Swindlehurst was born into in 1812, he of the hymnbook, who took part in the 1850s Sea Trek and ended up in Utah.

1783: Ron: Here is an interesting snippet, given the period we are now dealing with, from my text book (The family historian's enquire within, by Pauline Saul) " 1783 A Stamp Act was passed. This decreed that a duty of 3d had to be paid for every entry of a birth or christening, marriage or burial. The duty was collected by the incumbent who was allowed to retain 10% as a commission. This came into force on 1st October but was repealed 10 years later. It had several interesting consequences. There was a great increase in the number of baptisms in the last few days of September 1783, many of the children being of several years of age and a similar 'bulge' after its repeal in 1793. Those in receipt of parish relief were exempt from the tax, no payment being required for any person buried from 'any Workhouse or Hospital or at the sole expense of any Charity'.

GenLinks: **1783 stamp duty**

A stamp duty of 3d was placed on all entries and registers causing many families not to have children baptised. Paupers were exempt. Many entries of 'pauper' were made by the minister when parents would not pay. The duty was repealed in 1794.

Jacob married Jennet Pearson on 19th June 1786. Jennet was the daughter of William Pearson and his wife Elizabeth Rawlinson. I do not know why Jacob and Jennet were married in Lancaster and other than the event itself, there is no record of witnesses etc. It may well be that Jacob was living at Lancaster at the time.

The below copy of a census of Haverbrack near Beetham taken in 1801 included Jacob and Jennet. The bottom entry for 1 house; Jakob Swindlos Mails 4 Females 2

The six persons living in the house would appear to be Jacob, Jennet, 3 sons and one daughter.

The three sons would appear to be Isaac, William and Jacob as they survived into adulthood. The daughter would appear to be Ann who also survived into adulthood. Mary being 14yrs old may well have died or be away from home at census time.

As far as I am aware the children of Jacob and Jennet are as follows:-

Mary, Christened at Lancaster 3rd. January 1787.

Jenet, Christened at Beetham 30th January 1788 buried at Beetham 29th Feb 1788.

In the Parish Register for Beetham, Jacob is described at the 9th child of Jacob and Jennet. I can find 8. If there was another child, presumably it died an infant. **Jacob** born 1800. I have no information on him at all. I believe however that he died single in 1888.

Jacob, born 1766, was buried at Beetham on 7th February 1802. He was a cockle fisherman and was drowned, his body being found on the shore at Sandside. I have been unable to trace the coroners or other record of his death.

His wife Jennet had been Christened at Beetham on July 1759 where she died in 1829.

The above copy of the 1811 rent evaluation for Storth shows Jennet living in a cottage owned by her father, William Pearson (Senior). The Pearson family was quite large and well established in Beetham Parish.

They possibly took over the Sagar farm at Simonstone, although Sagars are recorded as farming in the village until comparatively recent times. William and Betty had 8 children and the eldest son John, born in 1794 continued farming there. This same John was my Great-Great-Grandfather.

The family obviously maintained its link with Bowland for Benjamin, one of the younger sons, married a girl from Mitton and returned to the area to work. Tragedy struck this particular branch of the family, when Richard one of their sons was drowned in the Ribble when still a young boy. Benjamin tried several jobs - working at Mitton, Clitheroe and finally at Padiham where he died in 1861. Incidentally, his family are referred to throughout Parish records as Swindlehurst (spelt with the 'd') and as far as is known his descendants have retained that spelling to this day.

Ar: My great-great-grandfather being 13 years older than his brother Ben, married Miss Ann Ashworth in 1818 and four children were born. James, the eldest, was born in 1819 and in later Census returns gave his birthplace as Whalley. Elizabeth (b.1821), John (b.1823) and Ann (b.1826) gave their birthplace as Simonstone, but as Simonstone at that time was within the parish of Whalley, they were probably all born at the farm.

James and John were destined to bring the family out of farming. They both married locally in the 1850's, the bride of John, my great grandfather, being Ann Stanworth of Higham and it is to this nearby village that our story moves. The Stanworths were farmers at Copthurst Farm, but John turned his attention to cotton weaving. A new mill was built at Higham village in 1852, at a time when the cotton industry was thriving in the area. An older mill at Fir Trees just outside the village towards Padiham was already in existence and Padiham itself was growing from a village into an industrial township, thanks to its new rail links with Burnley, Blackburn and Manchester and the ample deposits of coal at nearby Altham and Habergham.

Update from Dy 2013:

Sarah Tomlinson nee Swindlehurst - at the time that William Sw and Elizabeth (nee Eccles) moved form Quernmore (Over Wyresdale) to Wray to my knowledge they were the only family with the name Swindlehurst there. Another branch of the family (Ruth's branch) did move to Wray later on. As Sarah was born in Wray (source various census records from 1851 onwards but no birth/bapt record found for her)) it follows that she was the daughter of William and Elizabeth.

In 1851 in the Tomlinson household Thomas Swindlehurst is listed as brother to the Head of House Peter. I'm sure it should be brother-in-law. He is still in the household in 1861 and listed correctly as bro-in-law and is unmarried. The Tomlinsons lived next door but one to the Swindlehursts in 1851 and next door to a branch of the Sw in 1861.

Thomas Sw who lived with Sarah Tomlinson and remained unmarried all his life died in the 2nd quarter of 1880.
